Bill Description

This bill makes training assistance and training reimbursement a permanent appropriation and limits the assistance under the 6 million dollar training assistance appropriation (section 1) to mandated training only. It also allows for an annual consumer price index based increase to the 2.9 million dollar training reimbursement appropriation (section 2).

Assumptions

This bill potentially impacts local and individual officer costs and has no impact on POST Board costs or operations. It is assumed that local agencies will continue to conduct a great deal of training other than mandated training. Going forward, that additional training will only be reimbursable under the 2.9 million dollar appropriation
